**June 3 – 7, Week 1**

**10 am to Noon**

**Origami Adventures** (Ages 4-6) with Olivia Estes

Come and explore the basics of Origami! Learn about the art of folding paper and see what figures you can make from just a piece of paper. Origami increases manual dexterity, and produces excellent, decorative models out of paper which your child will be proud to show family and friends.

**What Does Summer Look Like?** (Ages 7-9) with Emily Charest

What Does Summer Look Like? Will take the students through Summer, representing Under the Sea with watercolor jellyfish, mosaic fish, and paper seahorses, Through Downtown Daphne with a one-point perspective drawing, a creation of a Sunset Silhouette to represent Summer in the country, and lazy, pooled Bubble drawings to show what Summer looks like during the day at home.

**Piece de Resistance!** (Ages 10 & Up) with Karlie Knight

We will explore several methods of resist painting. This class will get messy, and be a lot of fun! We will start with rubber cement and water color, and work our way up to acrylics and spray paint.

**1 pm to 3 pm**

**Wind, Flowers and Kites Oh My** (Ages 4-6) with Kathy Nicholson

Kites are blowing and bright flowers are growing. This class is all about the outdoors. Your child will learn to paint assemble and create using clay pots to make wind chimes, tissue paper kites and flowers galore.

**Art Wide Open: Exploring Art & Imagination** (Ages 7-9) with Becky Kiper

We will explore different mediums – watercolors, mixed media, acrylics, and coloring. We will dive into the depths of our imaginations and see what comes out. We will talk about the importance of freedom with art. This will be a fun and creative endeavor for the children! Examples: string painting, magazine collage, watercolor, scribble art, dream animals, leaf art, etc.

**Techniques of Painting and Creating Textures** (Ages 10 & Up) with Paige Hatfield

In most paintings, detail is an illusion, and many different materials can be used to achieve this. This class will teach children basic ways to create lovely texture using simple materials such as plastic wrap, forks, salt, and more. Each child will leave the class knowing how to create basic illusions of detail, know how to use color to their advantage, and discover new painting techniques. On the last day they will learn how to make tissue paper flowers.

## **June 10 - 14, Week 2**

### **10 am to Noon**

**Pinch Pots and Beyond** (Ages 4-6) with Olivia Estes

Your child will create art pieces that are useful, decorative, and colorful. This class will engage their creative side and encourage them to think outside the box. We will make our own homemade clay with safe ingredients (flour, salt, glue, koolaid, and water). Pieces will be air dried so no firing will be required.

**Working With Geometrics** (Ages 7-9) with Emily Charest

Working With Geometrics explores different shapes in art and how to uniquely put them together through art. Creative shape drawings, constructive paper houses, hot air balloon cutouts, and a honey bee hex painting. Finally ending the week with a cardboard 3D geometric puzzle students can bring home.

**Beginner Acrylic Art** (Ages 10 & Up) with Teresa Gibbs

We will create simple acrylic art on canvas, beginning with drawing and then painting in acrylic.

### **1 pm to 3 pm**

**Swimming Fish, Dinosaurs and Portraits!** (Ages 4-6) with Kathy Nicholson

Handmade moveable fish made from construction paper will be a fun project your child will love. Clothespin people who look like me? We will guide your child to paint and assemble a little model of themselves using a clothespin. And have you heard....dinosaurs are back? We will make one but this one will fit in your pocket?

**Reduced-Reused-Reimagined** (Ages 7-9) with Loran Chavez

Let your child's imagination run wild with artworks created from what most people consider trash! We create all sorts of things that you will be proud to display. This year we are using wire and recycled paper for sculptures, pelican paper projects, abstract paintings, and torn paper paintings, if time permits!

**Paint With the Masters** (Ages 10 & Up) with Lyn Gordon

Students will select an impressionistic painting to trace on canvas using brush strokes. Some art history will be included and learning brush strokes. No experience needed.

## **June 17 - 21, Week 3**

**For the Love of Art** (Ages 4-6) with Olivia Estes

Children will be taught unique ways to create art using everyday objects such as straws, Q-tips, tinfoil, string, and much, much more. They will make leaf pressings, tie-dye stained glass, rock painting, and 3-D paintings. These art projects will engage their creative sides and help them think of new ways to express themselves.

Children will learn to make a necklace or bracelet by assembling their favorite piece of jewelry they can keep or give to someone they love.

**Simple Drawing and Painting Techniques** (Ages 7-9) with Paige Hatfield

Kids will learn basic techniques for drawing and painting. This includes animals, landscapes, and more!

**Paint With the Masters** (Ages 10 & Up) with Lyn Gordon

We will teach your children they can make a beautiful mosaic artwork out of small paper swatches. You will be surprised at how little hands can piece together paper to make a scene. Don't forget the alligators...this is a snappy fun craft project to make. Functional magnets the children make will hold all their artwork on display.

**Mixed Media Fun!** (Ages 10 & Up) with Denise Bourgeois

Students will create mixed media art using a variety of materials. The class will be very "hands on" with lots of allowance for exercising those creative minds. With a new theme introduced daily, the class promises to be a fun and productive time!

**10 am to Noon**

**Miss Mary's Puppy Puppet Workshop** (Ages 7 & Up) with Mary Ardis

Learn how to make puppy dog puppets and other critters with objects you can find right in your home, like socks, gloves, empty oatmeal containers, and empty coffee cans. Miss Mary and her puppy puppet, Cupcake, will inspire you to use your imagination and be creative in decorating and bringing your puppets to life.

"What's in the Water?" spends a week exploring different mediums while painting mermaids, alligators, and octopi. Exploring with watercolor paints, making 3D clay fish, and drawing chalk pastel turtles, the students will come home with crafts all about underwater animals.

**Story Book Central** (Ages 10 & Up) with Rachel Peck

Story Book Central is a chance for kids not only to learn about classic stories by illustrating different scenes from them, but they will also have the chance to create their own storybook character and story. They will create things such as Peter Pan's shadow, Rapunzel's tower, and even Charlotte's Web.

### **1 pm to 3 pm**

**Paper Doll Portraits, Fruit or Vegetables Anyone?** (Ages 4-6) with Kathy Nicholson

Boys and girls will enjoy making these paper dolls to resemble themselves or one of their friends. They draw in the face and add hair that matches the color of their own hair. Next on their plate is your child making their favorite vegetables from felt. Easy and fun, a creeping caterpillar will teach your child how to make patterns on this adorable creature.

**Explorative Art** (Ages 7-9) with Lauren Nalty

Students will explore a variety of media and materials, such as drawing, painting, and printmaking to produce their artwork.

**Introduction to Elements of Art** (Ages 10 & Up) with Anna McBane

Dive into a fun week of art camp where you will learn the basic elements of art that go into making a beautiful masterpiece. During this week, we will explore how to use patterns, lines, color, texture, and perspective. Students will learn how to use these elements by experimenting with an assortment of medias such as watercolors, acrylics, and oil pastels!

## **July 22 - 26, Week 6**

**For the Love of Art** (Ages 4-6) with Olivia Estes

Children will be taught unique ways to create art using everyday objects such as straws, Qtips, tinfoil, string, and much, much more. They will make leaf pressings, tie-dye stained glass, rock painting, and 3-D paintings. These art projects will engage their creative sides and help them think of new ways to express themselves.

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**Imagination Station** (Ages 10 & Up) with Loran Chavez

This class will allow your child to use problem solving while creating works of art! I use a lot of recycled materials, and I encourage the kids to let their minds work overtime while creating. This week we will make sculptures from various materials, magazine paper pelicans, cardboard sculptures with dimension. Time permitting we may do an abstract painting on recycled material too!

**1 pm to 3 pm**

**Puzzle Blocks, Changing Seasons and Me** (Ages 4-6) with Kathy Nicholson

Stacking the blocks they just made will make the children giggle with delight when they complete their wooden blocks of people or animals. While creating a four seasons tree, the children will learn about the changing seasons of Winter, Spring, Summer and Fall. Children will have fun expressing themselves with drawing a portrait to share for all to see.

**Mixed Media Fun!** (Ages 7-9) with Denise Bourgeois

Students will create mixed media art using a variety of materials. The class will be very "hands on" with lots of allowance for exercising those creative minds. With a new theme introduced daily, the class promises to be a fun and productive time!
